



On March 24, 2011 the Requester submitted a request for records to the City of Philadelphia Police Department ("Department") pursuant to the Right-to-Know Law, 65 P.S. §§67.101, *et seq.* ("RTKL"). The Department invoked an extension and issued a denial on April 29, 2011.

An appeal must be filed within 15 business days of the mailing date of the agency's response, or the date of a deemed denial. The appeal was filed on May 31, 2011 and is therefore untimely.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal is **dismissed as untimely** and the Department is not required to take any further action. This final determination is binding on all parties. Within thirty (30) days of the mailing date of this Final Determination, any party may appeal to the Philadelphia County Court of Common Pleas. 65 P.S. § 67.1302(a). All parties must be served with notice of the appeal. The OOR also shall be served notice and have an opportunity to respond according to court rules as per Section 1303 of the RTKL.
