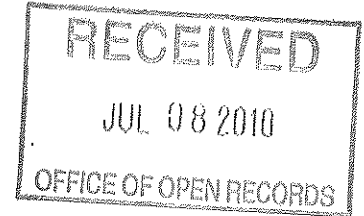

Joseph Keating hereby petitions for reconsideration of the Pennsylvania Office of Open Records (OOR) June 23, 2010, Final Determination (FD) in the above-captioned matter. In that FD, the OOR made a factual error in its conclusion.

It is my understanding in the above referenced matter that the Office of Open Records has concluded in granting the requester's appeal and requiring Covington Township to obtain the reports from a third-party contractor and provide copies of them to the requester.

I believe that a factual error has been made and it should be directed that "Covington Township" provide copies of the Plumbing Inspection Compliance reports. This would eliminate any confusion about a third-party contractor.

Therefore, the petitioner respectfully requests that OOR grant reconsideration of the June 23, 2010, Final Determination to conclude and direct that Covington Township provide copies of the Plumbing Inspection Compliance reports to the requester within (30) days.


